465 out of 792 pupils (59% of pupils) completed the survey – 41 pupils more than 2023 - thank you very much.

9. My school is helping me to become confident. (0 point)




63% of pupils agreed or strongly agreed that the school is helping them to become more confident.



15. My school takes my views into account. (0 point)




51% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that St Thomas of Aquin's takes their views into account.

In 2023, 64% of Pupils strongly agreed or agreed that they were given good advice to make choices about taking the subjects that are right for me.


18. Staff help young people to be responsible for their (0 point) own behaviour.


#### 22. I feel that my work in school is hard enough. (0 point)
